In The Dark

Course Designer: Joel Peters

START POSITION: Lying in the prone position behind rifle at Port A. Arms are outstretched 90 degrees to your body.

GUN READY CONDITION: Loaded rifle at Port A, loaded pistol on shelf at B, loaded shotgun at C.

STAGE PROCEDURE: On signal, engage T1-T10, USP 1-4 and P1-2 with rifle from Port A only. Leave on-safe rifle at A, move to shelf B and engage T11-T20 with pistol as visible. Move to position C and place on-safe pistol in box, retrieve shotgun and engage remaining steel targets and clay birds.

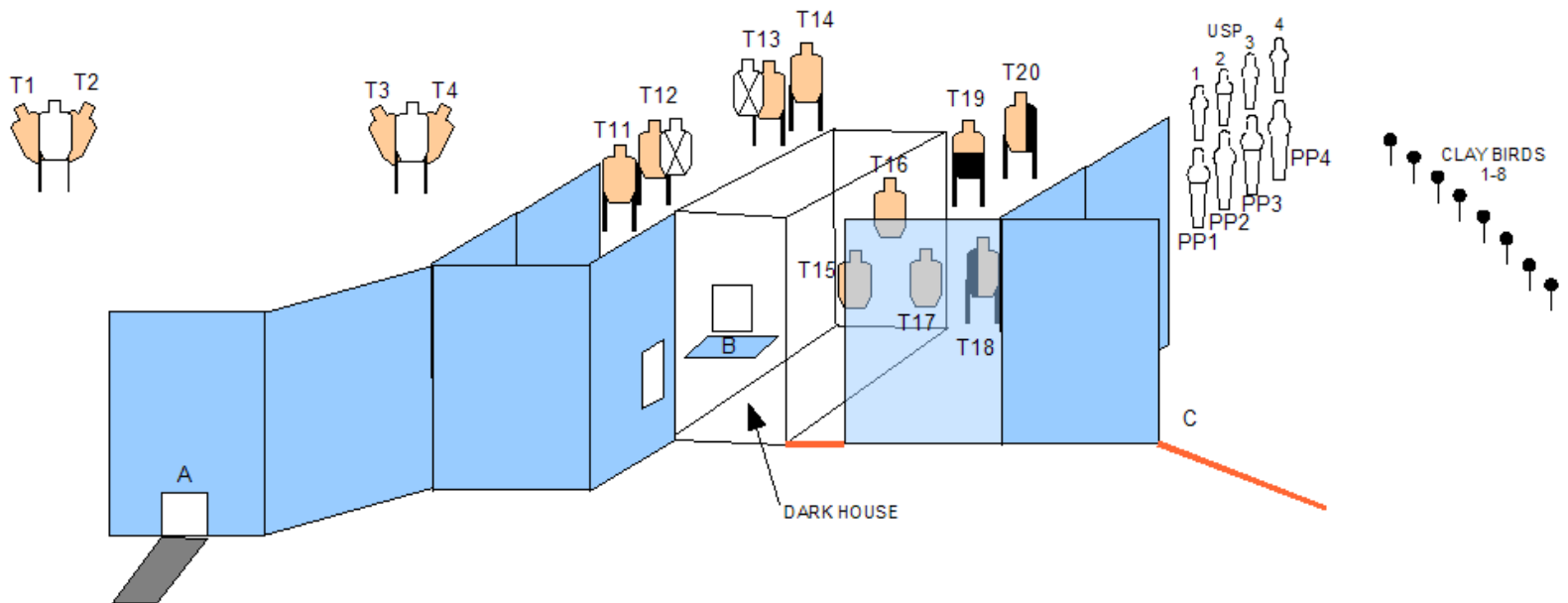
SCORING: Time plus, 62 rounds (26 rifle, 20 pistol, 16 shotgun birdshot)

TARGETS: 20 IPSC, 8 USP, 4 PP, 8 Clays

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD steel = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

RULES: USPSA current edition



SETUP NOTES: Flashlight will be needed to see and engage T15-T17. One will be provided or shooter can use their own. Abandonment Box will be set at Position C next to wall. Set rifle steel at approx. 100 yards.
