



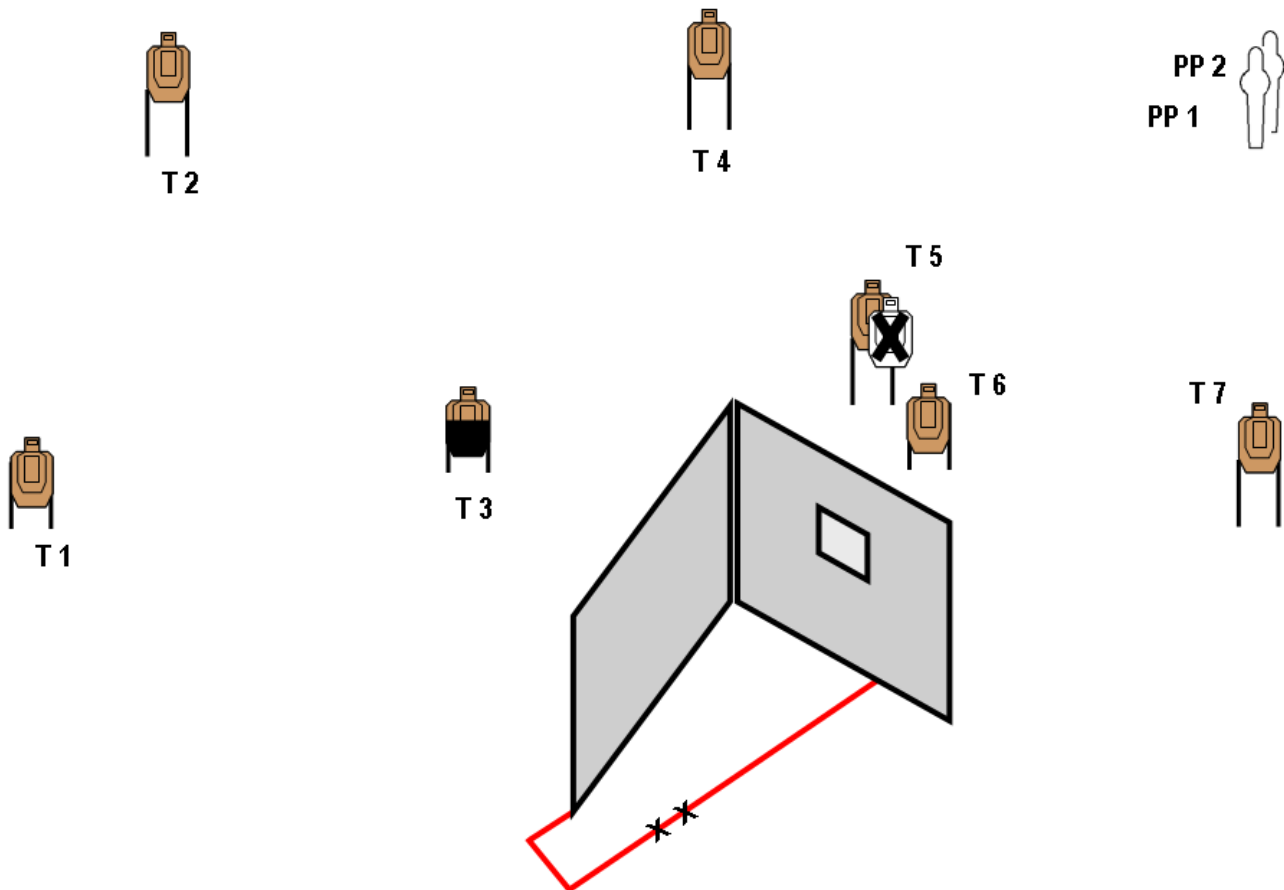
# Sweet Sixteen

<p><b>Starting Position:</b> Standing with heels of both feet touching the two "X" marks on the up range fault line as shown on the diagram below. Hands are naturally at sides. Shoulders are square with the fault line.</p>	<p><b>Scoring:</b> Comstock, 16 rounds, 80 points</p> <p><b>Targets:</b> 7 IPSC Metrics, 2 IPSC Pepper Poppers</p> <p><b>Scored Hits:</b> Best 2 per IPSC Metric Steel Down = 1A</p> <p><b>Start-Stop:</b> Audible - Last shot</p> <p><b>Penalties:</b> Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10</p> <p><b>Rules:</b> USPSA Current Edition</p>
<p><b>Gun Ready Condition:</b> Loaded gun is holstered per USPSA Current Edition.</p>	
<p><b>Stage Procedure:</b> On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.</p>	



### Set up Notes:

- Set steel at least 10 yards down range of the farthest down range fault line.
- Use tape to form two "X" marks on the farthest up range fault line on the right as shown in diagram above.
- T4 is visible from both the left wall and portal views.
