



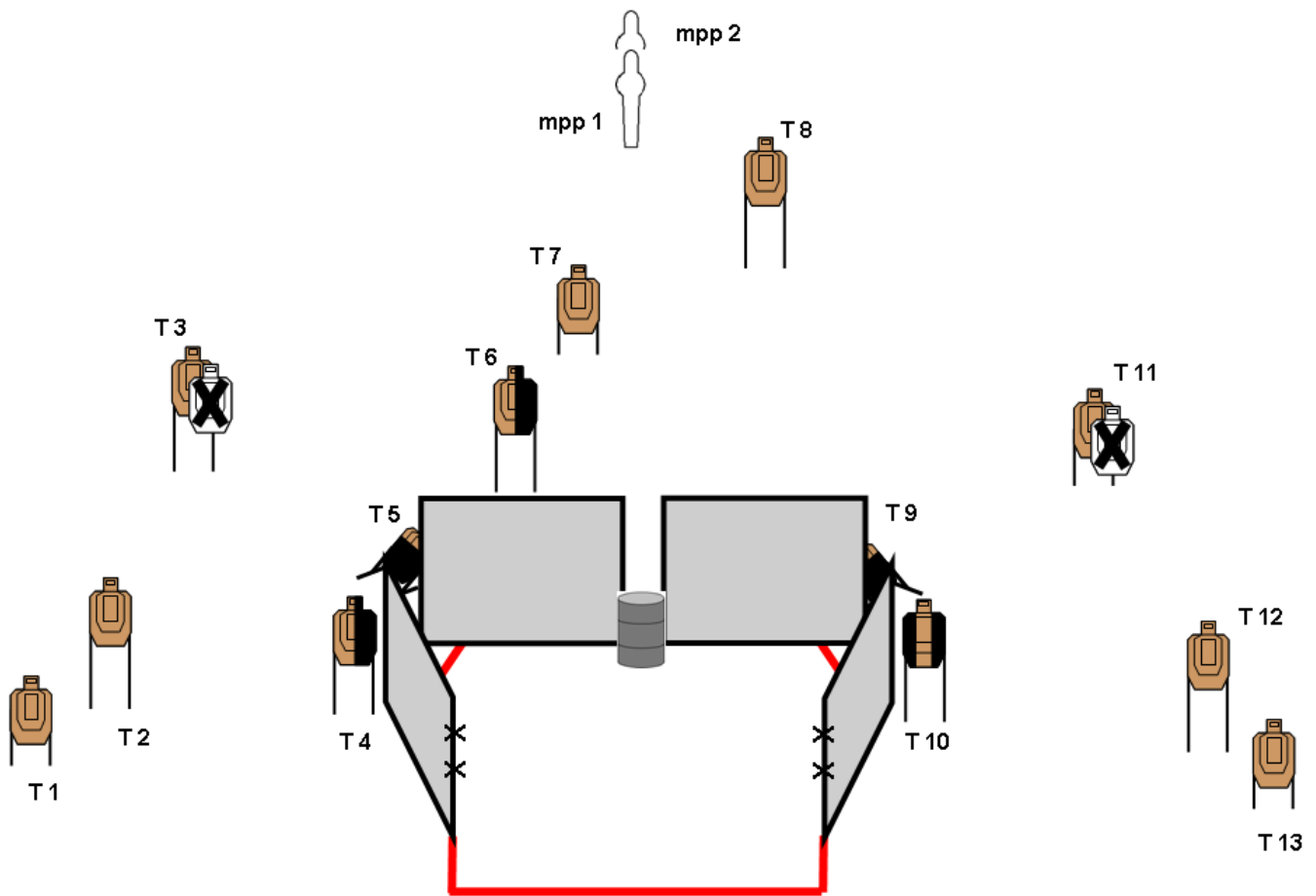

<p>Starting Position: Standing with palms of hands on either of the two "X" marks on the farthest up range edges of the left or right wall.</p>	<p>Scoring: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points</p>
<p>Gun Ready Condition: Loaded gun is holstered per USPSA Current Edition.</p>	<p>Targets: 13 IPSC Metrics, 2 Mini Pepper Poppers</p>
<p>Stage Procedure: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the shooting area.</p>	<p>Scored Hits: Best 2 per IPSC Metric Steel Down = 1A</p> <p>Start-Stop: Audible - Last shot</p> <p>Penalties: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10</p> <p>Rules: USPSA Current Edition</p>



Set up Notes: See attached Lines Of Sight (LOS) diagrams for desired LOS views.

- Set steel at least 10 yards down range of the farthest down range fault line.
- Use tape to form two "X" marks on the farthest up range edge of the barrier walls at the left and right sides as shown in the diagram above.
- T1, 2, 3, 10, 12, and 13 can only be viewed from the the "X X" mark views without breaking the 180.
- T5 and T9 are on angle feet and can only be viewed from the left and right down range corner wall openings.
