

Written Stage Briefing Clam Up and Drop

Stage Designer: Dave Bridges, BSPSC Match Date: Click or tap to enter a date.



Clam Up and Drop is a 17 round, 85 point Comstock course. There are 8 USPSA targets and 1 USPSA Popper. The best 2 hits per paper will score.

The start position is standing inside shooting area, shoes touching X marks, wrists below belt. Handgun loaded and holstered.

PCC: Start position is standing inside shooting area, shoes touching X marks. Loaded PCC held in both hands, stock on belt, pointed downrange with safety applied.

On the audible start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area as they become visible.

Popper PP1 activates T4 which remains visible at rest AND T5 which is a disappearing target.
